

PLEASANT VALLEY ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

Tuesday, February 24, an open discussion meeting was held at City Hall to present the proposed changes to Pleasant Valley Road and NE Antioch Road. This meeting was a joint presentation by Gladstone and Kansas City engineering staffs. Approximately 100 people came to view the changes and to share comments about this project.

Here is a brief synopsis of that meeting:

- —Pleasant Valley Road would be rerouted to the north side of Atkins Johnson Farm.
- —Current entrance roundabout will remain and the road will flow east from there.
- —Road will be a typical 3 lane road in Kansas City's portion with a sidewalk on the north side and a bike path on the south side.
- __N. Antioch Road will be improved in Gladstone to include sidewalks and bike lanes on both sides (still 2 lanes).
- _Old Pleasant Valley Road will end near Shoal Creek Cemetery with a cul-de-sac and the N. Jackson portion will be removed. See map attached.
