It can pay to know your neighbors.

Are your neighbors strangers to you? Here's an account by Captain Will Akin, Emergency Management Director for the Clay County Sheriff's Department, that may give you a different perspective on getting to know your neighbors.

Captain Akin responded to a call from residents just returning from vacation about a residential burglary. When he arrived at the residence he expected to find a home that was missing television sets and other electronics items, jewelry, etc. Instead, he found a house that was totally bare of furnishings or any other items. It looked like the residents had moved out. During his investigation he questioned the neighbors and asked whether or not they had noticed any activity at the house. The neighbors said they had noticed a U-Haul truck in the driveway and people loading and moving items all day long. They said they assumed their neighbors were moving!

To try and avoid something like this happening to you, Captain Akin recommends getting to know your neighbors. And when absent on vacation let *trusted* neighbors know



you will be gone so they can report any suspicious activity to the police or sheriff's office.
