Sunday & Monday/January 26 & 27 – Maui

Tuesday/January 28 – Hilo, Hawaii

Its 4,050 square miles are home to the snow-capped, 14,000-foot peaks of Mauna Loa and Mauna Kea, the fiery landscape of Hawaii Volcanoes National Park, vast macadamia nut plantations, black sand beaches, orchid-filled forests and posh resorts. Hilo is this island's capital. (B, L, D)

Wednesday/January 29 – Kona, Hawaii

Located along Hawaii's western shore, where the slopes of Mauna Loa and Hualalai meet the sea, the Kona Coast is a region of endless lava fields and golden Pacific sunsets. The clear waters are perfect for diving, snorkeling, and deep-sea fishing. At the heart of the Kona Coast lies the charming resort village of Kailua. This snorkeling haven is also home to the Captain Cook Monument. (B, L, D)

Thursday & Friday/January 30 & 31 – Kauai

From the soaring cliffs of the Napali Coast to the vast chasms of Waimea Canyon, Kauai embraces the senses like no other destination. The Garden Isle of Kauai is a land of towering ocean cliffs and incredible green valleys, pristine rain forests and cascading waterfalls plus some of the world's most photographed beaches. (B, L, D)

Saturday/February 1 – Honolulu, Oahu

Because of your evening flight, we will take advantage of this last day in paradise by seeing Pearl Harbor, USS Arizona, and enjoy a Honolulu City Tour. Later you will transfer to the Honolulu airport for your overnight flight home. (B)

Sunday/February 2 – Home
