Day 1: Depart USA

Board your overnight flight to Rome.

Day 2: Arrival in Italy

Welcome to Italy! After clearing customs and immigration, you will be met by your tour guide and transfer to your hotel in **Sorrento**. Sorrento's fabulous location is ideally situated for exploring the surrounding area straddling cliffs that look over the **Bay of Naples** and **Mt. Vesuvius,** to the west, and the **Amalfi Coast** to the north, it's the perfect location for an extended stay. Check into your hotel and relax. A Welcome dinner in a local restaurant is included this evening.

Day 3: Sorrento - Amalfi Coast - Positano - Ravello After breakfast we will depart for an excursion along the Amalfi coast. Today, enjoy breathtaking scenery, glamorous resorts hidden away on the spectacular corniche that winds its way past citrus plantations, vineyards and tiny villages clinging on to jagged cliffs. We'll tour Positano, a town full of fashionistas, celebrities, jet-setters and fashionable shops. The next stop is Ravello. Sitting like an ornate decoration atop a fancy cake in the hills above Amalfi, Ravello is a must see. Spectacular costal views and grand villas with perfectly laid out flower beds, palm trees, sculptures and fountains. Then it's off to tour Amalfi itself. The first view of Amalfi is unforgettable, with its tightly packed villas and palaces seeming to tumble down the cliff side into the fishing port and beach below. Amalfi was once a maritime power to rival Venice, and its golden age is symbolized by its stunning cathedral and the Piazza Duomo. Later return in Sorrento and enjoy time some to relax.

Day 4: Sorrento - Isle of Capri

Capri is an enchanting and picturesque island, a favorite with Roman emperors, the rich and famous, artists, and writers. This morning after breakfast, you'll be transferred to the harbor for your journey to the **Isle of Capri** by highspeed boat. Upon arrival to the port of Capri, our transportation takes you to Anacapri. You'll have free time to visit **Villa San Michele**, located on the northeastern side of Anacapri, the home of Swedish doctor and writer Axel Munthe. Later we return to Capri for lunch on your own. In the afternoon you have some free time, perhaps to see the **Blue Grotto** or head to the top of **Monte Solare** by chair lift for breathtaking views of the island.

Day 5: Sorrento at Leisure - Optional tour to Naples

Enjoy a day at leisure or join the full day optional excursion guided tour of lively city of Naples. Here we will enjoy a panoramic city tour seeing the Cathedral with its treasure chapel and basilica, dating back to the 4th century. You'll also drive to Plebiscite Square to see the Royal Palace, the beautiful church of St. Francesco di Paula, the Town Hall Square and the New Castle built by the French Family of Anjou. Before returning to Sorrento, you'll have some free time to explore Naples at leisure. Dinner is on your own tonight.

After breakfast, enjoy an excursion of **Paestum**. Paestum's unforgettable Unesco-listed temples are among the bestpreserved monuments of Magna Graecia. Paestum is one of the most famous and important archaeological sites in Italy. The ruins of Paestum include the walls, four majestic and well preserved temples, the amphitheater and the Via Sacra. The area is also famous as producer of Mozzarella Cheese. On the way back to Sorrento we will stop at a local **Mozzarella Cheese Factory** for a demonstration and tasting.

Day 7: Sorrento - Pompeii - Rome

This morning after breakfast depart Sorrento enroute to Rome. Along the way we will visit to the haunting ruins of **Pompeii** and take you back to the fateful day in 79 A.D. when **Mt. Vesuvius** erupted, covering the prosperous Roman city in deadly volcanic ash. On our visit to Pompeii you'll be able to explore the fascinating site. You'll see the **Forum, the Thermal Baths, Vetti's House** and the "Lupanare" brothel, all buried by volcanic ashes during the eruption. We will arrive in Rome and check into our hotel. This evening enjoy Rome at leisure.

Day 8 - Rome Sightseeing & Vatican Museum

After breakfast, start your day off with a **Rome city tour** to view many of the iconic sights of the **Eternal City**, including the **Roman Forum**, **Piazza Venezia** and **the Colosseum**, able to hold 55,000 spectators who watched the Emperor's games here. Continue on to **Vatican City** and stand in awe of **St. Peters Basilica** which houses Michelangelo's, the *Pieta*. Entrance is included to tour the **Vatican Museums** and see unparalleled collections of archaeological treasures, relics, paintings, sculptures and Michelangelo's greatest masterpiece, the **Sistine Chapel.** Tonight, enjoy a Farewell Dinner with your fellow travelers at a local restaurant.
