Omaha, Nebraska is your destination on this exciting trip that is sure to get you in the holiday spirit!

Day 1: Wednesday, December 3rd

Your first stop will be Brazenhead Irish Pub. The bar at Brazenhead was designed in Dublin, built in Wexford, Ireland and then shipped over to the United States. The bar was then reassembled under the supervision of Irish joiners. You will enjoy a delicious Irish lunch and entertainment. Next you will experience an Irish Christmas at Father Flanaganøs Boys Town. In 1917, a young Irish priest named Father Edward J. Flanagan grew discouraged in his work with homeless men in Omaha, Nebraska. He shifted his attention and in December of that year, borrowed \$90 to pay the rent on a boarding house that became Father Flanaganøs Home for Boys. Since then, Boys town has become one of the largest non-profit child-care agencies in the country. You will visit the Father Flanagan House, decorated according to a traditional Irish Christmas, and youøl enjoy a guided tour of the campus and tour the impressive Hall of History Museum. This evening you will experience Christmas in Germany at the German American Society. Youøl enjoy a holiday program of dancing, singing and food! Youøl listen to traditional German holiday favorites by the Menøs Choir, and shop for crafts and items imported from Germany at the Christmas Market. Your hotel is the Doubletree Suites by Hilton. *(Lunch and dinner are included today)*.

Day 2: Thursday, December 4th

Youøre in for a full day of fun beginning with a stop at the Lithuanian Bakery where youøl taste mouthwatering Lithuanian tortes and find out how these multi-layered treats are delicately handcrafted. Next, youøl visit Omahaøs famed botanical gardens, Lauritzen Gardens. During the holidays, their floral display hall is transformed into a celebration of the season with a beautiful poinsettia display and evergreens, twinkling lights and other festive decorations. You will enjoy lunch and a Kolachy making demonstration at the Bohemian Café. Your next stop is the Tea Smith where youøl enjoy a presentation on the blending and flavoring of holiday teas. Youøl sample some teas and learn interesting facts about each tea. Youøl visit the Mormon Visitors Center where you will view over 100 gingerbread houses of all shapes and sizes. This evening will be one of the highlights of your trip when you participate in The Madrigal Christmasse Feaste. Announced by fanfares and accompanied by music, mirth and traditions, the multi-course meal is designed to delight you and to celebrate Christmas. Every person, from your table server to the kingdomøs favorite performer, is dedicated to making this an unforgettable event. From the rousing Wassail Toasts to the last spoonful of plum pudding and the final fading melody of the Madrigal Syngersø performance, you will be enchanted and filled with the spirit of Christmas. (*Breakfast, lunch and dinner are included today*).

Day 3: Friday, December 5th

This morning you will experience a Ukrainian õLinens & Traditionsö presentation at the hotel. Olesia Reprichowskyj will bring various Ukrainian linens and tell about their connection to Ukrainian history, customs and traditions. Next, you will visit the Durham Museum in Omahaøs impressive Union Station. You will see Omahaøs largest Christmas tree in the main hall and several smaller Christmas trees that have been decorated by Omahaøs ethnic communities. The museum itself contains everything from antique passenger trains to exhibits from the Smithsonian. Experience Christmas in Greece when you visit the St. John Greek Orthodox Church for lunch and a tour of the Byzantine Style church. You will be amazed by the décor of gold and traditional icons. You will hear about the meaning of the décor and the history of the Greek Orthodox Church and their holiday traditions. (*Breakfast and lunch are included today*).
