**LUNCH OUT AT VIVILORE - THURSDAY, AUGUST 14** - This popular eatery in Independence serves modern American cuisine and they have a shop full of hand-picked antiques and treasures. You will pay for lunch on your own. Cost: \$8.00 includes transportation. Bus departs at 10:45 a.m. and will return at approximately 1:30 p.m. Deadline: August 8th.

**ST. JO FRONTIER CASINO - TUESDAY, AUGUST 19** - Lunch is free for our group in the buffet. Cost: \$12.00 includes transportation. Bus departs at 8:45 a.m. and will return at approximately 3:30 p.m. Reservation deadline: August 12th.

**INDEPENDENCE HIGHLIGHTS - WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 20** - Your first stop will be the Harry S. Truman Presidential Library where you'll experience the eventful and triumphant life of America's 33rd President. You'll visit the National Frontier Trails Museum and learn the history of the Santa Fe, California and Oregon Trails and the personal trials and adventures of the pioneers who opened the west. Next is the 1859 Jail, Marshal's Home & Museum. This two-story 1859 Jackson County Jail, with its barred windows, double iron doors and leg chains, once housed Frank James, Jesse James' notorious brother. At the Community of Christ Temple you will get to hear the 102-rank, 5,700-pipe organ, played by one of the church organists. Lunch is included today at Ophelia's on the Independence square.
