DAY TRIPS

All day trips depart from the west side of
Happy Rock Park, 76th & old Antioch Road.

“PASSAGES, TREASURES OF THE BIBLE”- TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 30 - This special traveling exhibit is in Springfield, Missouri until the end of the year. The exhibit features the largest collection of rare biblical texts and artifacts in the entire world. Highlights include the earliest known virtually complete translation of the Psalms to English, one of the first Gutenberg Bibles, and the second largest collection of the Dead Sea Scrolls. The exhibit tells the dramatic story of the Word of God from its beginning as scribbling on stone and papyrus to the invention of the printing press and smart phones. The artifacts are displayed in different rooms including a Christian Scribe chamber, a Jewish Synagogue, and a cave where Jerome translated the bible into Latin.
