## Friday, December 4<sup>th</sup>

You will travel to St. Louis, Missouri this morning. Your first stop will be the Missouri Botanical Garden where you will enjoy lunch before touring their holiday exhibits. The annual Gardenland Express Holiday Flower and Train Show delights visitors of all ages with G-scale trains of many eras traveling along 900 feet of track through a miniature holiday landscape made up of festive decorations and thousands of fresh plants, accented by beautiful poinsettias and flowers. You@l also visit the Tower Grove House and see the Victorian country home of Garden founder Henry Shaw decked for the holidays in true Victorian style. Next you@l visit St. Louis Cathedral featuring one of the largest mosaic collections in the western hemisphere. You@l enjoy dinner in historic St. Charles, one of the largest designated Historic Districts in the state of Missouri. After dinner take in some of the many activities of the St. Charles Christmas Traditions Festival. Carolers stroll the streets, the smell of roasting chestnuts fill the air and jingle bells can be heard. Your hotel is the Embassy Suites in St. Charles. *(Lunch and dinner are included today)*.

## Saturday, December 5<sup>th</sup>

This morning you@l learn about the history of St. Charles with a guide. You will see Missouriøs First State Capitol, the Shrine of St. Philippine Duchesne, the Foundry Art Centre, the beginning of the Booneøs Lick Trail, and many historic buildings dating from the 1790øs to the early 1900øs. After your tour you will enjoy the Festival activities. Visit Santaøs Cottage inside the Historic KATY Depot. While there be sure to experience õSantaøs Train Landö, an interactive 0-27 train display. Main Street comes alive with the music, pageantry, and spectacle of one of the best loved Christmas Traditions events: the Santa Parade. Cheer and celebrate as all of the Christmas Traditions characters and carolers come together in a special procession. You wonøt want to miss the paradeøs grand finale, as a cavalcade of international Santaøs, each carrying the flag of their native land, heralds the arrival of Santa and Mrs. Clause and their horse-drawn carriage. Following the parade, youøl depart for Gladstone. *(Breakfast is included today)*.
