

Heritage Highlights Itinerary

Day 1: Flight to Buffalo, NY - Niagara Falls

Day 3: Niagara Falls - Lancaster, PA

This is the land of the "plain people", where time has stood still for over one hundred years and represents the oldest Amish settlement in North America. Day 4: Lancaster - Gettysburg - Lancaster

This morning visit the somber grounds of **Gettysburg National Military** Park, site of one of the bloodiest battles of the Civil War. This afternoon visit an Amish Farm and House to learn about their faith, culture and way of life that forbids the use of electricity or telephones in the home.
