Grace & Holy Trinity Cathedral, erected in 1890, an interesting fact about this church is that The first Baby Wellness Clinic in the world was established through the women of Grace and Holy Trinity in 1922. Building started on the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in 1882. When the Cathedral opened it was the tallest building in Kansas City. Tickets were sold to persons wishing to ascend the staircase to see the view. You will enjoy a tour of each of the churches and enjoy lunch at Anthony's.
