START SMART BASKETBALL

This 6-week basketball program is for 3 to 6 year old children and will meet once a week for 6 weeks. This program will teach the children the basic motor skills necessary to play organized basketball while they work one-on-one and spend quality time with their parents. The program focuses on teaching children and their parents dribbling/ball handling skills, shooting, passing/catching, and running/agility without the threat of competition or the fear of getting hurt.

This program will be offered in four different sessions. All sessions will meet at Ravenwood Elementary School (5020 NE 58th Street). The deadline for enrollment is December 12th or until filled, whichever comes first.

All sessions will be held from 6:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. First class dates for each night are:
