#### DAY TRIPS

**WEST BOTTOMS ANTIQUES - FRIDAY, JUNE 7** - It's the First Weekend in the West Bottoms, which means that many of the most prominent and popular antique dealers open their shops to reveal their thrifty picks to the masses. Storefronts such as Good Ju Ju, Bella Patina and Nook and Cranny KC open doors early on Friday to reveal undiscovered treasures, including vintage and antique goods. There are food trucks and café's here for lunch. Cost: \$10.00 includes transportation. Bus departs at 9:00 a.m. and will return at approximately 2:00 p.m. Registration deadline: May 31st.

**ST. JO FRONTIER CASINO - FRIDAY, JUNE 21** - You'll enjoy famous name slots and video poker machines plus many table games. A buffet lunch featuring pizza, pasta and salad is included. Cost: \$12.00 includes transportation. Bus departs at 8:45 a.m. and will return at approximately 3:30 p.m. Registration deadline: June 7th.

**BREAKFAST, BLOOMS & GINGER ROGERS - SATURDAY, JUNE 22** - The Bingham-Waggoner Estate, sitting on over 19 acres near the Independence Square is truly a one-of-a-kind gem in Independence, Missouri. This well preserved Estate, with more than 90% original furnishings, carpets and paintings, provides insights into the lifestyle of the 19th century wealthy residents. On June 22nd they will have their annual event - Breakfast & Blooms. You will enjoy a delicious breakfast, a tour of the mansion and see planting demonstrations. Next you will visit The Owens-Rogers Museum Home where Ginger Rogers was born. You will see many of the original features that were in the house at the time. View unique items and gowns that were owned by Ginger, including the dress she wore to the academy awards in 1967. Cost: \$53.00 includes transportation, breakfast and tours. Bus departs at 8:30 a.m. and will return at approximately 2:00 p.m. Deadline: June 14.

**QUALITY HILL PLAYHOUSE "BROADWAY AND ALL THAT JAZZ: SONGBOOK OF THE 80S TO THE PRESENT" - THURSDAY, JUNE 27** - Nothing describes American musical theatre of the 1980s to the present better than "over the top." Characterized by lavish spectacles and epic plots, musicals like THE PHANTOM OF THE OPERA, LES MISÉRABLES, MONTY'S PYTHON'S SPAMALOT, and WICKED continue to captivate us with their "bigger is better" approach. On the flipside, American popular artists such as Rod Stewart, Joni Mitchell, Michael Buble, and even Lady Gaga (in partnership with the incomparable Tony Bennett) returned to the humble roots of the Great American Songbook for contemporary - yet classic - hits. Lunch is included before the show at Pierpont's in Union Station. Cost: \$63.00 includes transportation, lunch and show. Bus departs at 10:30 a.m. and will return at approximately 4:00 p.m. Registration deadline: May 29th.

**STONEHENGE & THE KANSAS CITY STREETCAR - TUESDAY, JULY 9** - Over 1.5 million people annually travel to the south of England to experience this mysterious wonder and World Heritage site, dating back 5,000+ years. Now, within this, America's premiere exhibition, step back into ancient civilizations and ask the "Who", "How" and "Why" yourself. You will encounter 300 original artifacts (150 of which have never traveled outside Europe) and learn what 20 years of groundbreaking scientific research has revealed.

This must-see exhibition is here for a very limited time. After visiting the Stonehedge exhibition, you will board the Kansas City Streetcar, and get off at the Kansas City River Market where you will have time for lunch and shopping. **HISTORIC ATCHISON, KANSAS - THURSDAY, JULY 11** - As one of the most history-rich cities in Kansas, Atchison is brimming with intriguing sites to explore. Highlights include: Amelia Earhart's birthplace home - on July 24, 1897, aviatrix Amelia Earhart was born in this home, built by her grandfather in the early 1860s. Recent renovations have returned the birthplace to its condition at the turn of the century when Earhart lived here with her grandparents; Evah C. Cray Historical Home Museum - built in 1882, it is distinguished by a three-story castle-like tower. Ornate fireplaces, carved woodwork and original chandeliers mix with Victorian furnishings. St. Benedict's Abbey - established by Benedictine monks in the late 1850s. About 40 monks reside at the abbey, which was completed in 1929. It features a 44-foot-high nave ceiling, unique frescoes, and facing choir stalls where monks gather three times a day for common prayer. Mt. St. Scholastica - the Benedictine Sisters of Mount St. Scholastica have been in Atchison since 1863. The Chapel is rich with beautiful marble, a large rose window and stained-glass windows honoring seven martyred women saints. A vaulted ceiling graces the interior of the choir chapel, which has facing choir stalls and stained-glass windows retelling the life of St. Benedict. Cost: \$50.00 includes transportation, lunch and tours. Bus departs at 8:30 a.m. and returns at approximately 5:30 p.m. Registration deadline: June 21st.

**PRAIRIE BAND CASINO - TUESDAY, JULY 16** - Your chance to win awaits on one of the 1,200 slot machines and a variety of table games. When you arrive to the casino you will receive \$20.00 on your players club card to be used in the casino. Lunch is on your own at the casino. You must have a valid government issued ID to get a players club card. Cost: \$15.00 includes transportation. The Gladstone bus will be used for this trip. **TWO GREAT MEN: PERSHING & DISNEY - FRIDAY, JULY 19** - Explore a piece of America's military history at the Gen. John J. Pershing Boyhood Home State Historic Site in Laclede, MO. and learn about the experiences that molded a Laclede country boy into one of the nation's legendary generals. Pershing and his family moved into the nine-room Gothic-style house in Laclede when he was six. Prairie Mound School, where Pershing taught prior to his admission to the U.S. Military Academy at West Point, is also on the site and includes a unique exhibit that allows visitors to pass through many of the same doorways Pershing passed through on his journeys from Missouri to Mexico and France. Next you will travel to Marceline, Missouri to the Walt Disney Hometown Museum. Walt Disney first came to Marceline, Missouri by train when he was five years old. The museum contains a unique collection of Disney family effects, not able to be viewed anywhere else in the world. Visitors to the museum are treated to interpretive exhibits focusing on the Disney family and Walt's life in Marceline. Cost: \$92.00 includes motor coach transportation, lunch and tours. Motorcoach departs at 7:45 a.m. and will return at approximately 5:30 p.m. deadline: June 20th.

**LUNCH OUT AT GHENGIS KHAN - THURSDAY, JULY 25** - Locally owned since 1995, Genghis Khan is Kansas City's original (and best) Mongolian Grill.
