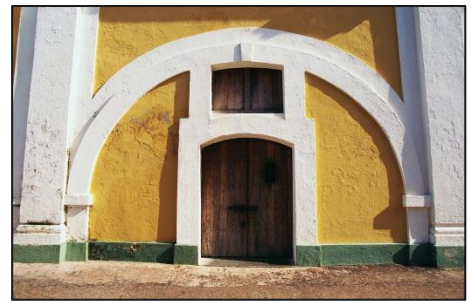

### **January 20 – San Juan, Puerto Rico**

### **January 21 – Charlotte Amalie, St. Thomas**

### **January 22 – Basseterre, St. Kitts**

Discovered in 1623 by the British and settled by the French in 1625, the island's deep colonial history is reflected in the abandoned fortresses, as well as its landscaped gardens, city squares and architectural details.

### **January 24 – Willemstad, Curacao**

Curaçao is the largest of the six islands that comprise the Netherlands Antilles. With the growth of the oil industry in Curaçao in the early 20th century, workers and their families came to the island from more than 50 countries, providing a varied and vibrant population. Everyone should experience the sights, sounds and energy of this unique destination.

Located on the picturesque southern coast, Oranjestad is the historic Dutch capital of Aruba, where the traditional, tall, multicolored houses combine carved wooden doors and typical Dutch tiles with open-air patios.
