

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE VIII OF THE MODEL TRAFFIC CODE (GLADSTONE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 4.100.020) TO ESTABLISH A STOP SIGN LOCATION AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION AT NORTH BALES AVENUE AND NORTHEAST 72ND TERRACE.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Gladstone, Missouri desires to maintain the safety and well being of the citizens of Gladstone, Missouri in connection with traffic control and has determined the necessity for an additional stop sign location.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLADSTONE, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. ONE (1) NEW STOP SIGN ADDED. SCHEDULE VIII of the Model Traffic Ordinance (Gladstone Municipal Code Section 4.100.020) is hereby amended by the addition of the following new stop sign location:

SCHEDULE VIII - LOCATION OF STOP SIGN.

NO. 763 **NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF NORTH BALES AVENUE AND NORTHEAST 72ND TERRACE** governing southbound traffic on North Bales Avenue.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage.

RE: Traffic control signage request on NE 72nd Terrace at N. Askew Avenue and N. Bales Avenue

Public Works recently received a request for no parking signs on NE 72nd Terrace at N. Askew Avenue.

After review of the area, letters were sent to the adjacent residents requesting their input on this request. Out of the twelve (12) residents notified, we received ten (10) responses. Six (6) responses were against the designation of no parking in this area, three (3) were in agreement with the no parking request, and one (1) had no opinion. After reviewing the responses, staff does not recommend the designation of no parking in this area.

The primary concern mentioned in the original request references sight distance issues when turning onto NE 72nd Terrace. Staff has determined that a permanent stop sign is warranted due to the sight distance issue. Therefore, staff recommends that stop signs be placed at N. Bales Avenue and N. Askew Avenue where they intersect with NE 72nd Terrace. The stop signs will be installed on the northwest corner of both intersections governing southbound traffic.
