AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AMEND THE SHOAL CREEK TRAIL COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, TO INCLUDE THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A DOG PARK AND NEIGHBORHOOD TRAIL EXTENSION IN THE VICINITY OF HAPPY ROCK PARK.

Legislative Findings

- 1. Gladstone and Kansas City worked together to design and construct Shoal Creek Trail Phase 4; and
- 2. Gladstone served as the lead agency on the project with Kansas City conveying construction funding by cooperative agreement; and
- 3. It is the intent of both Cities to cooperate again on the design and construction of a new dog park and neighborhood trail extension with Gladstone again serving as the lead agency; and
- 4. Kansas City has agreed to utilize the remaining balance from the construction of Shoal Creek Trial Segment 4 to fund their portion of the work; and
- 5. It is in the best interest of the citizens of Gladstone and Kansas City to work cooperatively to complete these public improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLADSTONE, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

THAT, the City Manager of the City of Gladstone, Missouri, is hereby authorized to execute an amendment to the existing Shoal Creek Trail Cooperative Agreement with Kansas City, Missouri, to design and construct a dog park and neighborhood trail extension in the vicinity of Happy Rock Park.
