

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE VIII OF THE MODEL TRAFFIC CODE (GLADSTONE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 4.100.020) TO ESTABLISH STOP SIGN LOCATIONS AT THE NORTHWEST AND SOUTHEAST CORNERS OF THE INTERSECTION AT NORTH HOLMES STREET AND NORTHEAST 70<sup>TH</sup> STREET.**

**WHEREAS**, The City Council of the City of Gladstone, Missouri, desires to maintain the safety and well being of the citizens of Gladstone, Missouri, in connection with traffic control and has determined the necessity for additional stop sign locations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLADSTONE, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1. TWO (2) NEW STOP SIGNS ADDED.** SCHEDULE VIII of the Model Traffic Ordinance (Gladstone Municipal Code Section 4.100.020) is hereby amended by the addition of the following new stop sign locations:

Subject: Amend Schedule VIII of the Model Traffic Code to establish new stop sign locations at the northwest and southeast corners of the intersection at N. Holmes Street and NE 70th Street.

Background: Stops signs are currently located on the northeast and southwest corners of the intersection at N. Holmes Street and NE 70<sup>th</sup> Street governing westbound and eastbound traffic. Pedestrian crosswalks also traverse each leg of the intersection which can confuse some drivers. Furthermore, construction of the new police headquarters is anticipated to distract some drivers and reduce site distance at the intersection. The installation of new stop signs on the northwest and southeast corners of the intersection governing northbound and southbound traffic will address this situation.

Budget Discussion: Funds are budgeted in the amount of \$ 250 from the General Fund. Ongoing costs are estimated to be \$ 0.00 annually. Previous years' funding was \$N/A.

Public/Board/Staff Input: The Police Department and Public Works Department recommend amending Schedule VIII of the Model Traffic Code to establish new stop sign locations at the northwest and southeast corners of the intersection.
