AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN UPDATED EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN FOR THE CITY OF GLADSTONE, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, the City of Gladstone recognizes the imminent danger its citizens could face in the event of a disaster; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gladstone, in response to this concern, has developed and revised a comprehensive Emergency Operations Plan; and

WHEREAS, this Plan addresses those occurrences that require an extraordinary commitment of government resources; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Operations Plan was developed through the combined efforts of the City of Gladstone, the Gladstone Emergency Management Agency and the State Emergency Management Agency; and

WHEREAS, this Plan is an all-hazards plan which provides for emergency response, life safety and property preservation, disaster recovery, and mitigation of hazards; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Gladstone, Missouri, supports all efforts and actions of the City Staff to protect the lives of Gladstone citizens, preserve property in Gladstone, and improve the quality of life for all of its people through the creation of a safer environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLADSTONE, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

THAT, THE CITY OF GLADSTONE UPDATED EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN, is hereby approved, and the Mayor, City Manager, and the Emergency Management Director are hereby authorized to affix their signatures to the Gladstone Updated Emergency Operations Plan for implementation of the Plan.

FURTHER, THAT, this ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage.
