POLICE VEHICLE PURCHASE

The 2015 Public Safety Sales Tax (PSST) Fund Budget authorized \$60,000.00 for the purchase of two new police vehicles and equipment. A resolution authorizing the purchase of two (2) 2014 Dodge Charger Police vehicles has been included on the agenda for the City Council Meeting on Monday, July 28, 2014.

The Mid America Council of Public Purchasing (MACPP) facilitates a cooperative purchasing process for government agencies and other member public sector organizations. MACPP utilizes a competitive bid procedure that ensures the best prices for procuring equipment and vehicles, including police vehicles. The City of Independence managed the bid process for the 2014 model year police vehicles. The bid for Dodge Charger police vehicles was awarded to Landmark Dodge Chrysler Jeep, 1900 S. Noland Road, Independence, Missouri.

Captain Ken Buck contacted Larry Wilson, Fleet Manager at Landmark Dodge and informed him of our need for new police vehicles. Mr. Wilson provided a confirmation on the price for two 2014 Dodge Charger police cruisers, quoting \$25,214.00 each for a total cost of \$50,428.00.

A resolution authorizing the purchase of two (2) 2014 Dodge Charger police cruisers has been placed on the agenda for the City Council Meeting on Monday, July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2014. Funds for this purchase was included in the 2015 Public Safety Sales Tax (PSST) Fund Budget.
