A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF A PROPOSAL FROM DICK SMITH FORD, RAYTOWN, MISSOURI FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) FORD POLICE INTERCEPTOR UTILITY 4X4 VEHICLES FOR THE TOTAL PURCHASE AMOUNT OF \$51,972.00.



Re: POLICE VEHICLES PURCHASE

The 2014 General Fund Budget authorized \$60,000.00 for the purchase of two new police vehicles and equipment. A resolution authorizing the purchase of two (2) 2015 Ford Police Interceptor Utility 4X4 vehicles has been included on the agenda for the City Council Meeting on Monday, December 8, 2014.

The Mid America Council of Public Purchasing (MACPP) facilitates a cooperative purchasing process for government agencies and other member public sector organizations. MACPP utilizes a competitive bid procedure that ensures the best prices for procuring equipment and vehicles, including police vehicles. The City of Independence managed the bid process for the 2015 model year police vehicles. The bid for Ford Police Interceptor Utility 4X4 vehicles was awarded to Dick Smith Ford, 9505 East 350 Highway, Raytown, Missouri.

Captain Ken Buck contacted Greg Lofton, Fleet Manager at Dick Smith Ford and informed him of our need for new police vehicles. Mr. Lofton provided a confirmation on the price for two 2015 Ford Police Interceptor Utility 4X4 vehicles, quoting \$25,986.00 each for a total cost of \$51,972.00.

A resolution authorizing the purchase of two (2) 2014 Ford Police Interceptor Utility 4X4 vehicles has been placed on the agenda for the City Council Meeting on Monday, December 8th, 2014. Funds for this purchase was included in the 2014 Public Safety Sales Tax (PSST) Budget.

Once the vehicles are delivered, installation of the consoles, police radios, computers, radar units, and application of the police decals/markings will be arranged. Please advise if you have any questions.

Chief Hasty,

I have researched the purchase of two new 2015 Ford Utility patrol vehicles on both the State of Missouri Highway Patrol Vehicle Bid and the Mid America Council of Public Procurement (MACPP). I have found the MACPP bid has the lowest price.

The City of Gladstone Purchasing, Procurement Card, Accounts Payable Policy states in section IV, E, that the process of competitive quotes and bids may be waived when it is advantageous to purchase through purchasing contracts of other governmental agencies.

The MACPP bid is through Dick Smith Ford and their price on the 2015 Ford Explorer Police Package equipped as our other units is \$25,986.00 each. I recommend placing an order through Dick Smith Ford on the MACPP bid for two 2015 Ford Utility vehicles at this time.
