A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE UPDATED REGIONAL MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN BY THE CITY OF GLADSTONE, MISSOURI, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE PARTICIPATING JURISDICTIONS OF THE REGIONAL MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN REVIEW COMMITTEE OF THE MID-AMERICA REGIONAL COUNCIL.
