Background: On October 12th, 2020, the City Council approved Resolution 20-48, which authorized the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the Northland Assistance Center and provide up to three (3) \$15,000 disbursements of CARES Act funds to the NAC for distribution to Gladstone residents who have been mpacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. As a result, the Northland Assistance Center has distributed the entire \$45,000 and helped many families in Gladstone with past due utilities, rent, mortgage payments and other emergency assistance needed as a result of the pandemic. The proposed amendment to the existing agreement with the Northland Assistance Center will allow for one (1) additional disbursement of \$15,000 to be distributed to Gladstone residents who qualify for the financial assistance.
