**FURTHER**, **THAT**, funds for such purpose are budgeted in the CWSS Fund as part of the 2023 Lease Purchase.



Subject: Purchase of a Vactor 2100i Combination Sewer Cleaner

<u>Background</u>: Staff requested a proposal from Key Equipment and Supply Company for a current model year Vactor 2100i built on a Kenworth T880 chassis utilizing Sourcewell cooperative pricing. Sourcewell holds hundreds of competitively bid cooperative contracts for use by government, education, and non-profit organizations. The unit is used for the daily cleaning and flushing of sanitary sewers and occasionally excavating around utilities during water main repairs.

Budget Discussion: Funds are budgeted in the CWSS Fund as part of the 2023 Lease Purchase.

<u>Public/Board/Staff Input:</u> It is the recommendation of the Department of Public Works to accept the Sourcewell proposal from Key Equipment and Supply Company for the total purchase price of \$549,983.24. This unit will replace the current 2016 Vactor 2100 Plus (Asset# 1519) which will be sold at auction at a later date. The new unit is available for immediate delivery compared to other units with lead times of a year or more.
