

Subject: Contract Amendment No. 3, Linden Connector Trail Design, Project TP2373

Background: The Linden Connector Trail is a proposed east-west trail through Gladstone from the Northland Innovation Center at 6889 N. Oak Trafficway to the intersection of Missouri Route 1 and NE 68th Street. The proposed trail will include a combination of on-street and off-street facilities as shown on the attached exhibit. The original design was authorized by Resolution R-22-60. Amendments No. 1 and 2 included minor design revisions to address property owner comments and to begin discussions regarding the possible expansion of parking for the Northaven Condominiums. The project was initially awarded \$475,000 in Federal Transportation Enhancement Funds and was recently awarded an additional \$245,000 (\$720,000 total). The total estimated construction cost is \$900,000. Amendment No. 3 will incorporate design revisions requested by the Linden Baptist Church and to reduce the amount of right of way required to construct the project and obligate the additional funds by a deadline of September 1, 2024.
