Subject: Change Order No. 3 to the FY25 Mill and Overlay Program, Project TP2506

<u>Background</u>: The contract for Project TP2506 was awarded to Metro Asphalt, Incorporated as authorized by Resolution R-24-42. Change Order No. 1 (authorized by Resolution R-24-54) expanded the scope of work to include additional streets and Change Order No. 2 included adjustments for field measured quantities. Change Order No. 3 authorizes additional streets funded by the Gladstone Special Road District, as well as emergency street repair work necessitated by a water main break on NE 64<sup>th</sup> Street just west of N. Oak Trafficway. Additional streets funded by the Gladstone Special Road District include N. Highland from NE 70<sup>th</sup> Terrace to NE 72<sup>nd</sup> Street, NE 70<sup>th</sup> Terrace from N. Highland to N. Troost, and NE 68<sup>th</sup> Street from N. Troost to N. Flora.
