# Downtown Gladstone N. Oak Complete Streets Project

In 2020, Gladstone and Kansas City (KCMO) completed the N. Oak Corridor – Complete Streets Plan, which identified a vision for the corridor from N. Indianola Drive to N. Barry Road. The goal of the project was "...to assess the feasibility and implementation of high-quality pedestrian-oriented infrastructure and successfully integrated transit while maintaining the vehicular needs of the corridor." The plan was partially funded with a Planning Sustainable Places grant administered through the Mid-America Regional Council (MARC).

The final version of the plan generally recommended no reduction in travel lanes (typical 4-lane configuration) and the construction of a separate shared-use path on the east side of the roadway. Furthermore, hybrid roundabouts were proposed at NE 69<sup>th</sup> Street and NE 70th Terrace for access management as shown on the attached exhibits.

Upon completion of the plan, the City submitted an application for construction funding to complete the recommended improvements from NE 69<sup>th</sup> Street to NE 72<sup>nd</sup> Street. The project was awarded \$4,392,000 in Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds in federal fiscal year 2024. The City has since requested and has been granted a schedule extension to fiscal year 2025 so time is of the essence.

In FY23, the Gladstone Special Road District funded Phase 1 of the project design in the amount of \$75,000 which included meetings with property owners along the corridor. Those meetings are complete and through that process; an alternate design concept was developed that included a single hybrid roundabout at NE 69<sup>th</sup> Street.

The City recently awarded Phase 2 of the project design in the amount of \$700,000 which includes the design of the both roundabouts, relocation of overhead utilities to a corridor directly west of N. Oak Trafficway, and other improvements recommended in the original plan. The City also secured financing for the construction of the improvements in the total amount of \$4.4M with an annual debt service \$220,000 over 20-years. That debt service reduces the size of the

annual street maintenance program. The Gladstone Special Road District agreed to fund the N. Oak project in the amount of \$250,000 at the last meeting.

# **Proposed FY25 Street Maintenance Program**

This year's proposed program includes approximately 7-lane miles of intermediate maintenance (microsurface) and 18-lane miles of mill and overlay. The Gladstone Special Road District contributed \$350,000 towards the annual street maintenance program at the last meeting as summarized below. This work is currently under construction.

# Old Antioch Road – NE 68th Ter to NE 72nd Street (FY27)

Gladstone was awarded \$1.4M in federal funds to construct curb and gutter, sidewalks, and bicycle lanes on Old Antioch Road from NE 68<sup>th</sup> Ter to NE 72<sup>nd</sup> Street. The estimated local match is \$1M.

#### **Vivion Road Trail (FY27)**

Gladstone and KCMO were awarded \$1.6M in federal funds to construct a trail on Vivion Road (US 69) from N. Mulberry to N. Oak Trafficway. The total estimated cost of the project is \$5.8M with an estimated local match of \$700,000 from Gladstone, \$1.4M from KCMO, and \$2.1M from MoDOT. Due to the complexity of the project, staff is continuing to work with KCMO and MoDOT to fully fund the project.
