Your adventure begins with a student lead tour of the College of the Ozarks, a Christian, no-tuition College where all students work on campus. The Fruitcake & Jelly Kitchen has produced its famous fruitcakes on campus since 1934, and today student workers, along with supervisors, bake more than 25,000 cakes a year. Visitors are welcome in the kitchen where a variety of jellies and the College's delicious apple butter are made and sold, and you may get a sample of the College's famous fruitcake! You will also visit the Williams Memorial Chapel, an outstanding example of neo-Gothic architecture. The structure, dedicated in 1956, features vaulted ceilings and impressive stained glass windows. The Keeter Center is the College's award-winning lodge and restaurant where you will have lunch before departing. You will enjoy the beauty of Dogwood Canyon Nature Park on an open air tram wildlife tour taking you past towering bluffs, breathtaking waterfalls and crossing creek beds by way of beautifully crafted stone bridges. This evening you will experience the Nashville Nights Billy Yates Dinner Show. This is the country you love, brought to you by legendary songwriter and singer, Billy Yates, and featuring an incredible lineup of notable music stars. (Lunch and dinner are included today).

Thursday, May 28th

Spend a day in the 1800s as Silver Dollar City brings you live entertainment, fabulous food, unique shops and world class craftsmen. With dozens of exciting rides, more than 40 daily live shows and a historical atmosphere that resembles the Ozarks during the 19th century, it's easy to see why Silver Dollar City theme park is one of Branson's top attractions. The 100-acre park has 12 stage venues, 30 rides and attractions, 12 restaurants, 60 shops and 100 resident craftsmen. On the Showboat Branson Belle, you'll enjoy a wonderful dinner, stunning views, and the power of music from the 60's to today performed by a troupe of singers and a four piece band. Themed after the majestic showboats of the 1800s, the Showboat Branson Belle evokes the spirit of a bygone era when riverboat adventure, glamorous travel and dazzling entertainment converged into what we remember as Those Grand Old Showboatin' Days! (Breakfast and dinner are included today).

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This morning you will visit downtown Branson and Branson Landing featuring 100 specialty stores. You will enjoy lunch at Paula Deen's Family Kitchen before departing for Gladstone. Your rest stop will be at the Osceola Cheese Factory.
