DAY TRIPS

All day trips depart from the parking lot on Campbell Street between 69th & 70th Street (next to the Community Center parking lot).

KANSAS CITY MONARCHS - TUESDAY, JUNE 29 - The Kansas City T-Bones have been rebranded as the Monarchs and will play at the Field of Legends, formerly known as T-Bones Stadium, in KCK. We will be cheering them on when they play against the Sioux Falls Canaries! Cost: \$29.00 includes transportation and infield reserved seats. Bus departs at 10:00 a.m. and will return at approximately 3:00 p.m. Registration deadline: June 23rd.

GARDENS & LUNCH - FRIDAY, JULY 9 - Today you will visit two of Kansas City's premier gardens. Kauffman Memorial Garden's Lush and diverse plant beds feature local and exotic botanicals, including some plant varieties not found elsewhere in the Midwest. Pruned foliage and flower plantings are framed by stone walls and artfully shaped around playful fountains and elegant pieces. Kansas City's Municipal Rose Garden in Loose Park is the realization of a dream that began in 1931 by a group of women led by Laura Conyers Smith. They established the Kansas City Rose Society which created the public rose garden in Loose Park. There are about 3,000 roses of about 130 varieties in the 1.5 acre garden. You will enjoy a delicious lunch at Buca di Beppo on the Country Club Plaza. Cost: \$40.00 includes transportation and lunch. Garden admissions are free. Bus departs at 10:15 a.m. and will return at approximately 3:00 p.m. Registration deadline: July 2nd.

AUSCHWITZ NOT LONG AGO. NOT FAR AWAY. - WEDNESDAY, JULY 14 - For the first time, 75 years after the liberation of Auschwitz, a touring exhibition dedicated to the historical significance of the camp is being presented to a U.S. audience. You will enjoy an afternoon matinee at the Brownville Village Theatre, one of the oldest repertory theatres in the state of Nebraska. The theatre's home is over a century old and was formerly the Brownville Christian Church. After the show you will enjoy a dinner cruise on The Spirit of Brownville where you'll enjoy the natural beauty of the Missouri River while eating a delicious meal. NELSON ATKINS MUSEUM OF ART - WATER LILIES - FRIDAY, AUGUST 20 - Claude Monet found solace in nature. In 1915, when he began work on Water Lilies, it was against the backdrop of World War I. In this moment of death, destruction, and chaos all around him, he chose to focus on a verdant portion of his garden that demonstrated life. Setting his easel outside near his pond at his residence in Giverny, Monet observed the shifting shapes, colors, and shadows on the water's surface amid the sounds of nature. A 10-minute light program that emulates the rise and fall of daylight will play every quarter-hour. The exhibition also features a short video of Monet painting in his garden at the outbreak of World War I. You will have time to enjoy all that the museum has to offer, and have lunch (on your own) at Rozelle Court, located in the museum. Cost: \$12.00 includes transportation. Admission to the museum is free. Bus departs at 10:00 a.m. and will return at approximately 2:30 p.m. Registration deadline: August 6th.

ARROW ROCK LYCEUM THEATRE "SISTER ACT" -FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 24 - Sister Act is the feelgood musical comedy smash based on the hit 1992 film that has audiences jumping to their feet! 
